A PARENT GUIDE TO MONDAY 15TH JUNE NURSERY, RECEPTION AND YEAR 1

WHAT TO WEAR?

Children must come to school in their PE kit ready for lots of active and outdoor learning, as well as their classroom activities.

WHAT TO BRING?

- A water bottle.
- A coat or waterproofs, and wellies.
- Sun cream and sunhat or cap.

You will only need to bring these on the first day.

We will then keep everything in school until the end of term.

WHAT NOT TO BRING!

Your child's book bag.

We are trying to limit the number of items which are passing from home to school on a daily basis. Your child will bring home a pack of reading books (Reception and Year 1) which we would like them to keep and read at home until the end of term.

Your Reading record book

Any communication will be kept on your child's usual electronic platforms such as Show my Homework, Tapestry or Teams.

Toys or comforters

These must not be brought to school. Please leave in the car for your child to look forward to at the end of the day.

WHAT TIME SHALL WE COME?

Star Bubble

Our Star pupils are in the Star bubble. These families will drive to the drop off point (see attached map) and the children will be collected by staff at 8.55am. Pick up times are 12noon, 12.30pm or 3.30pm.

Rainbow Bubble

Our Rocket and Reception children are in our Rainbow bubble. These families will drive to the drop off point (see attached map) and the children will be collected by staff at 8.55am. Pick up times are 12noon, 12.30pm or 3.30pm.

Sunshine Bubble

Our Year 1 pupils are in our Sunshine bubble. These families will drive to the drop off (see attached map) and the children will be collected by staff at 8.45am. Pick up time is 3.20pm.

WHAT IF I HAVE CHILDREN IN DIFFERENT BUBBLES?

- You may drop your children off at the first time and staff will ensure your child is accompanied as they wait or make their way to their correct bubble.
- Just look for your child's bubble picture in the drop off/ collection zone and a member of staff will meet you there.

WHO DO I CONTACT IF I NEED TO GIVE INFORMATION ABOUT MY CHILD?

These are the lead members of staff for each bubble.

To replace the face to face communications we usually have, please feel free to email the lead staff member for your child's bubble instead.

WHAT IF WE BECOME UNWELL?


- Please do not send in your child if they are feeling unwell.
- DO email school to let us know.
- If someone in the family is feeling unwell and is showing symptoms of Covid - 19 then please do not send your child into school.
- If your child becomes unwell during the school day then they will be seen by Mrs Seddon.
- If it is felt necessary to send your child home then they will remain with Mrs Seddon until you can collect them.
- If your household does have a confirmed case of Covid 19 then please follow government advice on who is to isolate and for how long. Please notify the school immediately.

DROP OFF AND COLLECTION ARRANGEMENTS
